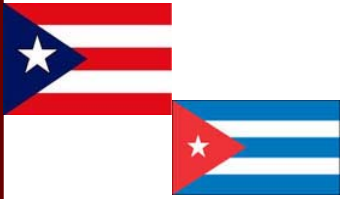


# AJI DULCE

## The Best of Mass



Aji dulce (*Capsicum chinense*) is a small, light green pepper that turns red if left long enough on the plant. In Puerto Rico, it is known as *ají dulce* or *ajicito* (sweet pepper and small pepper, respectively, in Spanish).



In the Dominican Republic, it is also known as *ají gustoso* or *ají cachucha* (tasty pepper, and cap-shaped pepper, respectively, in Spanish). It has the shape and size of a habanero pepper without the intense heat.



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
